General Description of Work:

The Men's recovery chaplain is responsible to provide recovery counseling, spiritual direction and coordinate volunteers to support the objectives of the new Life Recovery program. This position is also responsible for the implementation and administration of the curriculum needed for spiritual discipleship and recovery; and the promotion of a robust environment of recovery care in formal and informal settings including leading a family group.

Essential Functions

- Promote a vibrant transformational relationship with God in and among the Residents in the program community, including promotion and nurture of reconciliation, spiritual growth, identity formation, and service.
- Organize and administer curriculum, classes and groups specific to the needs of the men in the assigned phases of the program.
- Nurture a robust delivery of recovery care in both formal and informal settings including involvement by staff, resident peers, partners and churches.
- Work in cooperation with the Recovery Team Manager to implement ministry tasks that provide the greatest opportunities for discipleship and recovery in the program.
- Coordinate with volunteers and staff to bring continuity to Portland Rescue Mission's discipleship and recovery groups and classes.

General Functions

- Provide support as necessary in the areas of discipleship, case work, groups and counseling.
- Render assistance in crisis counseling and case management.
- Provide support to PRM in acting as liaison between PRM and the variety of volunteers, donors, and churches, which support the Mission.
- Participate in PRM special events including meetings, retreats and banquets.

• Seek integration of recovery care with other ministries, e.g., Outreach, Discovery Program, and Shepherd's Door.
